SUBJECT: Ensuring Your Safety in the Neighborhood

We wanted to take a moment to discuss an important topic that affects us all: safety in our community. Many of you have reported hearing gunshots in our neighborhood. While Prince George's County Police department is ultimately responsible for areas within its jurisdiction, it is crucial to be aware of potential risks and adopt preventative measures to ensure your wellbeing.

To this end, we have had security in our development for several years. Moreover, we have consistently directed our two officers to randomly patrol specific areas during overnight hours.

To enhance your safety, here are some valuable tips to keep in mind:

- If a threat is imminent, call 911.
- Be aware of your surroundings. Stay alert and pay attention as you exit and enter the garage and your vehicle. Look for suspicious individuals or activities, and trust your instincts if something just doesn't feel right.
- Secure your vehicle. Always lock your doors and ensure that your windows are closed before leaving your vehicle unattended. If your vehicle has an alarm system, activate it. Avoid leaving any valuable items in plain sight.
- Travel in groups, when possible. When returning to your vehicle, try to accompany a relative or friend, especially after hours.
- Trust your instincts. If you ever feel uncomfortable or notice any suspicious activity, trust your gut feeling.
- Please report any and all activity to our management company so that we can alert our officers
