MD 725 (Old Marlboro Pike) Drainage Repair Project at John Rogers Boulevard

In mid-April 2024, the Maryland State Highway Administration will begin a drainage repair project on MD 725 (Old Marlboro Pike) at John Rogers Boulevard in Upper Marlboro. The project will address a failed culvert across the North leg of John Rogers Boulevard.

To complete the repair, the North leg of John Rogers Boulevard at MD 725 will be closed for the duration of the project. Traffic will be detoured onto Brown Station Road. Advanced signage will be in place to notify drivers and pedestrians of the road closures.

The work will take place during off-peak traffic hours with temporary lane closures:

Weekdays: Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Weather and other construction factors permitting, the entire project will be complete by late summer 2024.
